

Titus County Livestock Sale

How to participate in the sale and add-ons

The sale begins on Saturday at 2:00 p.m. Sale program catalogues will be available in the office or at the sale ring. Chairs are set up at the sale ring for the convenience of the prospective buyers.

Please check in at the livestock office if you wish to participate in the sale and complete a buyer's info card or update your information that is currently on file.

You will bid as normal and when you purchase a project, you will give the Auctioneer your name. (See Buy Back System.)

If you wish to do add-on(s) you can get card(s) in the livestock office in advance or they will have them available at the sale. Just complete the information and turn the card(s) into the fair office or the ring men on the auction floor. All add-ons will be displayed on the scrolling screen near the auctioneer stand.

Anytime during or after the sale, you may come to the office and pay your bill for purchased projects and/or add-ons. Your detailed receipt will be mailed to you the next week. If project(s) bought are not paid for on sale day, **please pay within 30 days of receiving the invoice.**

How the Buy Back System Works:

The buyer purchases an animal for "price bid". If the buyer chooses to keep the animal the buyer pays the total bid. If the buyer chooses to do "Buy Back", meaning the buyer does not want to keep the animal himself, the buyer will pay the "bid price" minus the Buy Back listed in the program book.

Example: \$1000 bid price - \$200 Buy Back price = \$800 paid by the buyer. The company and/or person doing the Buy Back will be responsible for paying the \$200. The child/exhibitor will get the total \$1000 bid price.
